## Proposed Change for the Vigil Nomination Standing Rule


The LEC has decided to change the Vigil nomination standing rule. It is not official and will not go into effect until it is voted on at the January LEC. The original rule is, "The subcommittee shall be composed of all active Vigil Members, plus five Brotherhood and five Ordeal members under the age of

21 appointed by the Subcommittee Chairman and approved by the Key Three." The proposed rule is "The vigil selection committee shall be open to all arrowmen under the age of 21 with a minimum of 5 arrowmen, excluding only those who are eligible to be nominated for the vigil honor that year."



#### Wag-O-Shag Lodge Gives Back

The LEC has voted on donating some lodge funds to various



council fundraisers. \$2,000 will be donated to the council in the form of two James E. West awards.

Another \$350 will be donated to a Camp Long Lake Brick. This brick will be placed in the brick floor around the main camp flag poles that are in front of the Dining Hall. The money collected from all brick donations will be added to a Camp Long Lake Scholarship Fund which camp counselors can apply for.

Lastly, \$1,600 will be donated to the Friends of Scouting campaign which helps the council keep Camp Long Lake and other council activities running every year.
